RICHARD A. LIPSEY

DETAILS:

Millions of Americans can instantly recall where they were, what they were doing on Nov. 22, 1963, when President John F. Kennedy was assassinated and how they felt.

But Baton Rouge businessman Richard Lipsey's recalls being present for John F. Kennedy's autopsy.

As aide to Maj. Gen. Philip C. Wehle, the commander of the military district of Washington, D.C., at 1:30 p.m. on that fateful Friday, Lipsey remembers standing outside the home of Wehle, when the words "the president has been shot" first roared over the military chauffeur's car radio. Lipsey remembers bolting back toward the door of the house to tell Wehle the news, but by that time his boss was halfway to the car, ready to head to the office with Lipsey by his side.

But it is the aftermath of the assassination that sets Lipsey's story apart.

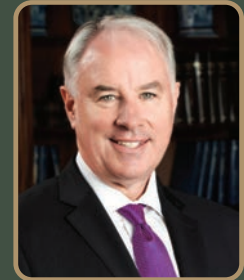

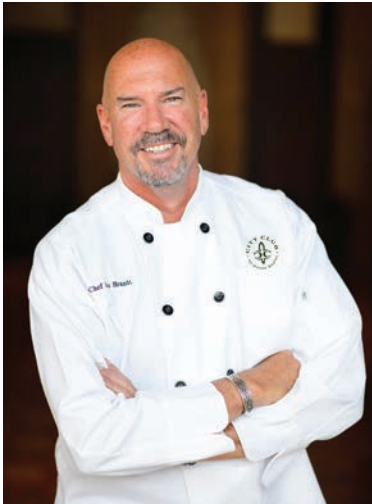
